

Dear Physician:

For a prefabricated LSO (lumbo-sacral-orthosis) or prefabricated TLSO (thoraco-lumbo-sacral-orthosis) to be covered by Medicare, all applicable Medicare statutory and regulatory requirements must be met. Medicare requires a physical evaluation of the patient, and **the following bullet points must be included in the <u>physician's chart note</u> (Medicare does not consider a letter part of the medical record). Please fax any Medicare compliant chart notes to our office.**

The physician must document AND DISCUSS the following:

1. Patient requires a LSO or TLSO

*The physician must also document AND DISCUSS at least one of the following:

- a. The orthosis is medically necessary to reduce pain by restricting mobility of thetrunk; or
- b. The orthosis is medically necessary to facilitate healing following an injury to thespine or related soft tissues; **or**
- c. The orthosis is medically necessary to facilitate healing following a surgical procedure on the spine or related soft tissues; **or**
- d. The orthosis is medically necessary to otherwise support weak spinal musclesand/or a deformed spine.
